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Iesus + *Christus* Candor lucis aeternae et speculum sine macula

cf. Wisdom 7:26

candor est enim lucis æternæ, et speculum sine macula Dei majestatis, et imago bonitatis illius.

For she is the brightness of eternal light, and the unspotted mirror of God's majesty, and the image of his goodness. (Douay-Rhiems)

Sacerdos in aeternum sancta semel ingressus proprio sanguine

cf. Psalm 109:4

Juravit Dominus, et non pœnitebit eum: Tu es sacerdos in æternum secundum ordinem Melchisedech.

The Lord hath sworn, and he will not repent: Thou art priest for ever according to the order of Melchisedech. (Douay-Rhiems 110:4)

cf. Hebrews 10:19

Habentes itaque, fratres, fiduciam in introitu sanctorum in sanguine Christi

Having therefore, brethren, a confidence in the entering into the holies by the blood of Christ. (Douay-Rhiems)

Pontifex maximus futurorum bonorum per tabernaculum non manufactum

cf. Hebrews 9:11

Christus autem assistens pontifex futurorum bonorum, per amplius et perfectius tabernaculum, non manufactum, id est, non hujus creationis.

But Christ, being come an high Priest of the good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hand, that is, not of this creation. (Douay-Rhiems)

Primogenitus mortuorum in redemptionem nostrarum prevaricationum

cf. Revelations 1:5

Jesu Christo, qui est testis fidelis, primogenitus mortuorum from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, the first begotten of the dead and the prince of the kings of the earth. (Douay-Rhiems)

Fragment S (f. 123r) 2

cf. Hebrews 9:15

Et ideo novi testamenti mediator est: ut morte intercedente, in *redemptionem earum prævaricationum*, quæ erant sub priori testamento, repromissionem accipiant qui vocati sunt æternæ hæreditatis.

And therefore he is the mediator of the new testament: that by means of his death for the redemption of those transgressions which were under the former testament, they that are called may receive the promise of eternal inheritance. (Douay-Rhiems)
