Arciconfraternita del Gonfalone 36 (formerly Mazzo XII)

Fragment T4, hand α (f. 141r–v): eighteen Latin inscriptions. The order of the inscriptions is probably f. 141v, col. 2, f. 141r, col. 1, f. 141r, col. 2; the single page was folded down the middle. Text is now lost in the binding margin. There is no indication of the purpose of the inscriptions; they may have labelled the various set elements in the Colosseum; or they may have labelled less imposing structures for a more modest performance elsewhere.
